Wednesday July 2nd- **Red White & Brews Day**- 5:00pm Co-Ed Shotgun @ Gray's Crossing.

- A patriotic afternoon on the links with your co-ed partner. Wear your Red, White, and Blue and we'll serve up some great afternoon brews. Plan to play only 9 holes so you have time to make it to fireworks. This is a Co-Ed scramble. Everyone starts on the Red Tees (including the guys). If you make a par, you stay on the reds. If you make a birdie, you slide back to the whites. If you make another birdie, you slide back to the blues! Keep in mind, if you make a bogey, you'll move UP a tee. The goal is to play as many holes as possible from the Blue Tees. *Par = stay on the same tee. Birdie = Move back a Tee. Bogey = move forward a tee.* Good luck!

- *In true Barracuda fashion, we'll be playing a Stableford format today. We've updated the points system to more closely mimic that of the PGA Tour with your level of play. All gals to play from the Red Tees. Points are as followed: Eagle or Better- +20, Birdies- +10, Pars- +5, Bogeys +2, Double Bogey +1, Triple Bogey or Worse- 0. Handicap strokes will be awarded, highest point total wins. Please record your stableford points only, no need for your actual score on the scorecard.*

- Come stroll the first few holes of Old Greenwood with mic'd up PGA Tour players, we'll ask questions, listen to stories and witness the finest players in the world play our home course. This is a TMC only event and extremely unique. Don't miss out, it was really amazing last year!

Wednesday August 20th - **Speed Golf**- *Regular 9 Holes of play @ 3:30pm Old Greenwood*

- Post round we'll report to the 1st tee for a fan favorite, Speed Golf! This is a 4 gal team, alternate shot speed golf competition (bring your running shoes if you'd like)! Part strategy, Part athleticism, we'll pair teams of four for a little athletic movement. Object of the game; hole out as fast as possible! You'll designate the order of play, and then strategically place your team around the hole. You'll be racing against the clock to hole out, fastest team to hole out wins! Don't worry you can use carts! And we'll bring drinks out to quench your thirst. Report directly to the 1st tee after regular play.

Sunday August 24th- **9 & Dine**- 4:00 @ Gray's Crossing

- Bring your partner, enjoy a late 9 followed by a dine at dusk

Monday August 25th- **Flag Tournament** -18 holes Old Greenwood starting at 8:30am

- The goal of a flag tournament is to get as far around the golf course as possible before putting your flag in the ground. The player whose flag is closest to the 18th pin is the winner. When do you put your flag in the ground? When you hit your allocation of shots. How many shots are you allocated? Par + Players Handicap (converted from #1 Tree) = total strokes allowed. For instance, you're a 12 handicap after converting from the #1 Tree, Par at Old Greenwood is 72, you'll receive 84 strokes. When you hit your 84th shot, place your flag in the ground wherever that shot ends up. The player that puts her flag in the ground the farthest around the course wins. Note! It is possible to play all 18 holes and still have strokes remaining. In that case, note how many strokes you have remaining.

Wednesday August 27th- **The Perfect Pitch**- 2:30 clinic followed by regular 9 holes of play @ Old Greenwood 3:30

- Ditch the board meeting and find yourself in the approach.

August 31st-September 2nd - **The Buzzsaw**- Tahoe Mountain Clubs Member-Guest Tournament

Monday September 8th-18 holes- **JUNK!**- 18 holes- 9:00am start @ Gray's Crossing-

- Today is all about the frills! Of course your score matters, but today, not as much. Junk is a dot scoring system to track how well the "little things" are being accomplished during your round. Today's scoring is as follows:

Teeies: 1 point if you hit the fairway with your tee shot (par 3's not included)

Stickies: 1 point if you hit the green in regulation on a Par 3

Pullies: 1 point for any putt made outside the length of the flag stick

Uppies: 1 point for any up and down (your approach misses the green, and you chip on and make your putt).

Duecies: 5 points if you don't 3 putt (or worse) any green during the entire round

Wednesday September 10th - **Ladies Club Horserace**- *Regular 9 Holes of play @ 2:30pm Old Greenwood*

- After your regular 9 holes, we're heading back out for a Horserace around 5:00pm! We'll randomly select teams of 2 to battle it out against the field as we eliminate groups along the way. Don't worry; we'll bring the drinks with us.

Monday September 15th- **Daytona**- 18 holes- 9:00 start @ Old Greenwood

- Sign up with a partner. In this 2 man NET game, you'll combine your two scores. For instance if you both make 4, your team score will be 44. If one player gets par or better, you'll put the lower number first. If the lowest score is over par, you'll put the bigger number first. Lowest team score wins!

Wednesday September 17th-**Knockdowns**- 2:30 clinic followed by our *regular 9 Holes of play @ 3:30pm Gray's Crossing*

- The "knockdown" shot is an abbreviated swing allowing you to control the trajectory of the ball. Whether you need to hit it under a branch, keep it out of the wind, or take off distance if you're between two clubs, the knockdown is an extremely useful shot.

Monday September 22nd-18 holes- 9:30 start @ Old Greenwood

Wednesday September 24th-**Co-Ed Par 3 Contest**- *3:30pm shotgun at Old Greenwood*

- *We've converted the front 9 into a par 3 course, bring your significant other, golfing buddy, daughter, neighbor, any one person to join you! Enjoy a casual afternoon on the links with great friends and plan to stay after for wine and drinks! 3:30pm shotgun at Old Greenwood*

Monday September 29th- 18 holes- 9:30 start @ Gray's Crossing

Wednesday October 1st- **Beat the Pro** 2:00 shotgun-Gray's Crossing

- It's almost time for us to call it a year, but before you do, here's your chance to beat up on the boss! Pro score vs. the best net ball score of the group. Bring it on!
